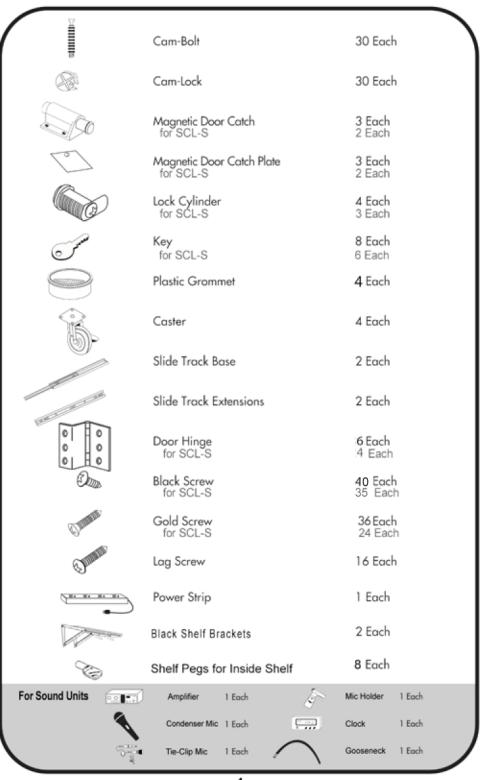

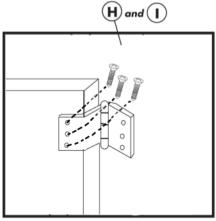


# **Step 1:** Insert all hardware into unit. **Step 1A:**

Take hinges and secure them to the doors (panels H(2) and I using three gold screws per hinge.

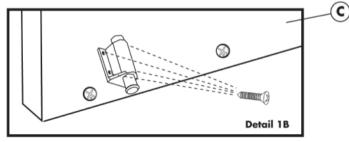

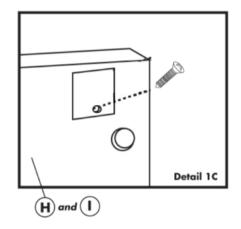
### Step 1B:

Attach magnetic door catch (3) to the bottom side of panel C using four black screws per piece using pre-drilled holes as a guide.



### Step 1C:

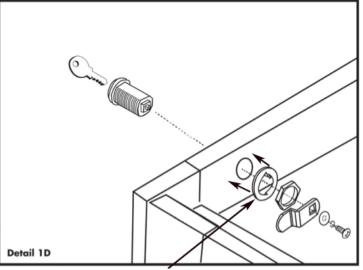
Using black screws, Attach 3 magnetic door catch plates to top side of door panels (H and I) using predrilled holes as a guide.



### Step 1D:

Install all four locks to the doors (3) and to the frame of the unit (1) as shown. Tighten using crescent wrench.

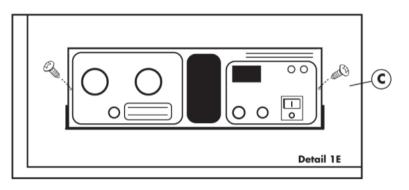


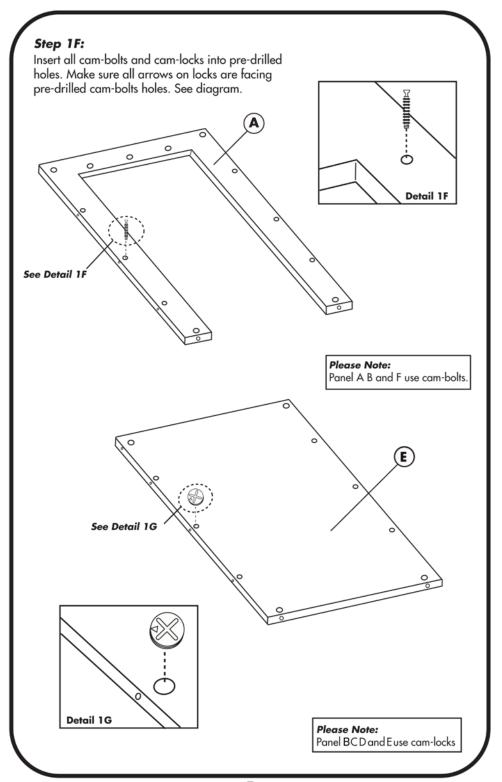


Using a mallet, secure the teeth of lock washer ring into laminate around predrilled hole, Then proceed with assembling other included hardware.

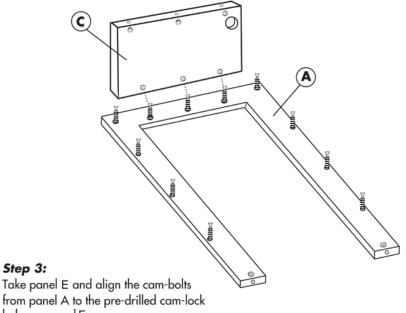
### Step 1E:

For sound version only. Using black screws, attach the Oklahoma Sound Series 200 Amplifier to Panel C as shown. Face of Amplifier should be facing upward (finished side of panel C). Wait until unit is fully assembled before installing amplifier.

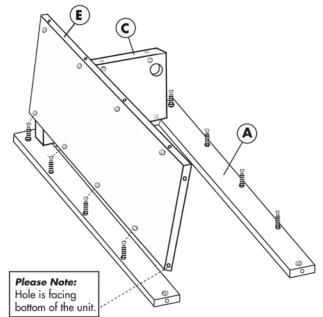




Take panel C and align the 3 cam-locks with the cam-bolts on the front side of the panel A. Grommet hole should be in the top right corner during assembly. Push panel down until flush against panel A. Tighten cam-locks by turning them clockwise.

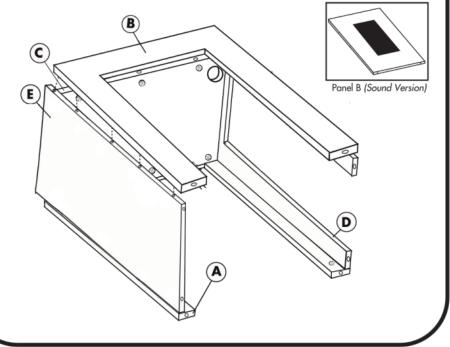


Take panel E and align the cam-bolts holes on panel E.



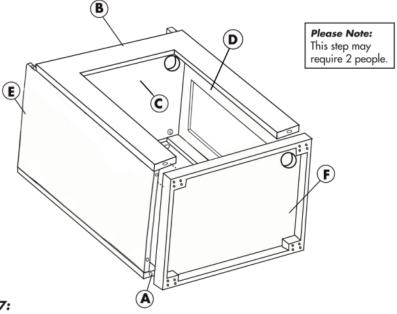
# Step 4: Repeat step 3 with panel D. See diagram.

Step 5:
Align cam-bolts from panel B with pre-drilled holes on panels
C, D and E. Make sure all sides are flush and tighten cam-locks.



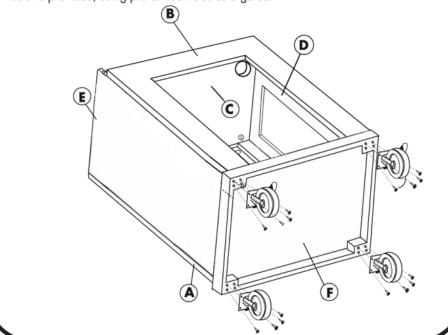
### Step 6:

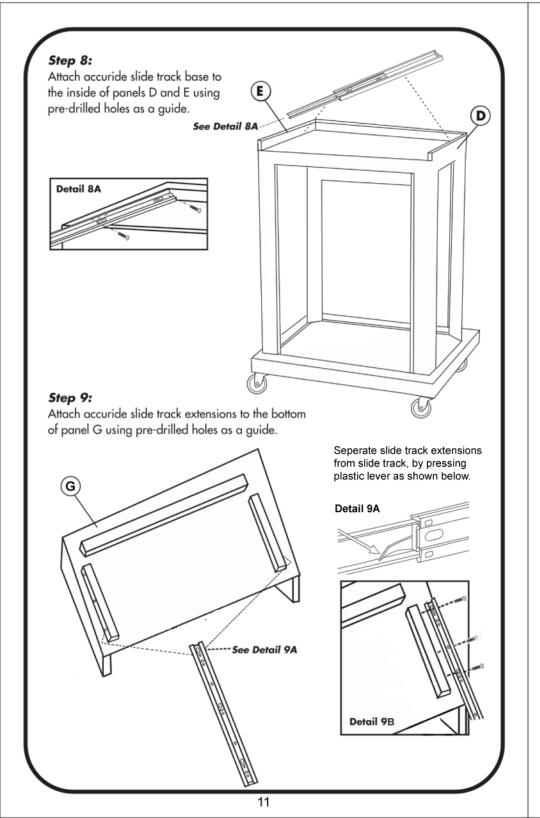
Align the 8 cam-bolts from panel F to the 8 pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the unit. Once all sides are flush tighten all cam-locks.

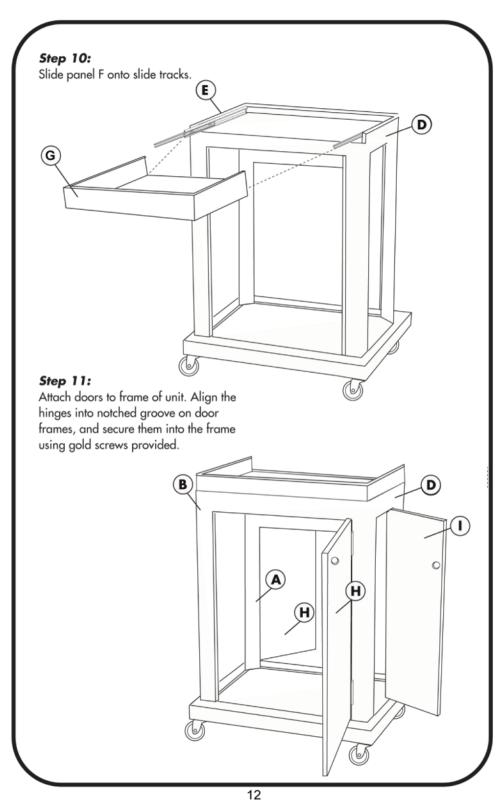


Step 7:

Attach 4 castors to bottom side of panel F using silver lag screws provided, using pre-drilled holes as a guide.

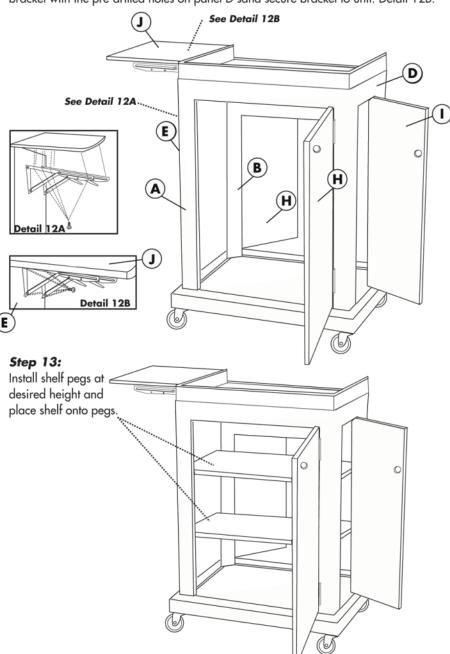






### Step 12:

Take panel J and align the pre-drilled holes with the holes on the top side of the bracket. Secure panel J to side shelf bracket (Detail 12A), using black screws. Take panel J with bracket attached and secure bracket into upright position. Align holes on bracket with the pre-drilled holes on panel D sand secure bracket to unit. Detail 12B.



### Step 14: (Sound Version Only)

Connect the female end of the white jumper coming from the amplifier to the male end coming from the speaker.

### Specifications of usage.

To put locks into locked position insert key and turn to the right. To unlock turn to the left.

Side shelf is in secured position when the side shelf brackets are locked. To unlock and close shelf, simultaneously press release levers on brackets and ease shelf down.

To put locking castors into locked position place foot onto lever on side of castor and apply pressure. To release brake do the same after you turn wheel so lever is facing upward.

Gooseneck and power strip should be installed wherever you are comfortable using it. To install gooseneck mount, use the three screws packaged in the polybag with the gooseneck mount.

### Sound version:

To use Oklahoma Sound amplifier make sure power switch is in the off position and plug unit into  $110\,v$  standard electrical outlet. Plug microphone into input labeled mic 1. Turn the amplifier power on, turn microphone power on, adjust volume and you are done.
