

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before using equipment.
- For your safety, the equipment is furnished with a properly grounded cord connector. Do
 not attempt to remove or disconnect the grounded connector.
- Install or locate the equipment only for its intended use as described in this manual.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals on this equipment.
- Do not operate this equipment if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, or if it has been damaged or dropped.
- This equipment should be serviced by qualified personnel only. Contact the nearest Duke authorized service facility for adjustment or repair.
- Do not block or cover any openings on the unit.
- Do not immerse cord or plug in water.
- Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not allow cord to hang over edge of table or counter.
- Turn the unit off, disconnect the power source and allow unit to cool down before performing any service or maintenance on the unit.
- The procedures in this manual may include the use of chemical products. You must read
 the Material Safety Data Sheets before using any of these products.

- The unit should be grounded according to local electrical codes to prevent the
 possibility of electrical shock. It requires a grounded receptacle with dedicated electrical
 lines, protected by fuses or circuit breaker of the proper rating, in accordance with all
 applicable regulations.
- Disposal of the unit must be in accordance with local environmental codes and/or any other applicable codes.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

UNPACKING UNIT


Inspect the shipping carton and/or container, carefully noting any exterior damage on the delivery receipt; also note any damage not evident on the outside of the shipping container (concealed damage). Contact the carrier immediately and file a damage claim with them. Save all packing materials when filing a claim. Freight damage claims are the responsibility of the purchaser and are not covered by the warranty.

- Follow the instructions on the Carton Box for unpacking the unit.
- Inspect unit for damage.
- Report any dents or breakage to source of purchase immediately.
- Do not attempt to use unit if damaged.
- Remove all materials from unit interior.
- If unit has been stored in extremely cold area, wait a few hours before connecting power.








6" Leg Option




INSTALLATION

Line up units in order to be installed.



Using a 3/8" Socket and ratchet loosen the bolts located under the front panel and lower about 3/8". Lift panel up and out to remove.







After data and electrical connections have been made, bolt units together using hardware provided. (213042/213023 Qty 4 ea.)



NOTE: DO NOT TIGHTEN AT THIS TIME






INSTALLATION

After units have been loosely bolted together level all units by turning the leveling feet.

CAUTION


Failure to complete this step could cause front panels not to install properly.

Standard Base






6" Leg Option



- 6 Tighten all bolts connecting all counters.
- 7 Re-install front panels.
 - a. Slide top of panel so the top clip engages with counter.
 - b. Push bottom in so that the adjustable bracket is sitting on the kick plate.
 - c. Make sure bottom of panel is in place by slightly pulling forward on the bottom of the panel.

AWARNING

Failure to make sure panel is in place could cause bodily injury.




Brackets


Kick Plate

- Using a 3/8" socket and ratchet, tighten adjustable bolts at the bottom of panel.
- **Bolts**




9 To install adjustable intermediate shelf, align hole pins on height selected on both sides.



- Converting to a Safe Unit a. Remove bottom shelves

 - b. Remove 2 bolts from each end of kickplate rail. (Total 4)



CLEANING COUNTER CORIAN® TOPS

Moist Dirt and Residue: Use soapy water and ammonia based cleaner, rinse and

wipe completely dry.

Note: DO NOT USE WINDOW CLEANER

Commerically available surface cleaners, such as Clean

EnCounters® will also work.

Preventing Hard Water Marks: Rinse and wipe completely dry after cleaning: clean up

spills before they dry.

Removing Hard Water Marks: Use cleaner formulated for removing hard water marks,

such as CLR® or Lime-A-Way®

Disinfecting: Occasionally wipe surface with diluted household

bleach - 1:100 (5 Tbsp. of bleach to 1 gallon of water, as recommended by the Centers for Diesease Control and

Prevention for disinfection of surfaces.
