Notice


- 1. Do not operate the drum caddy unless you are trained and authorized.
- 2. Please operate the drum caddy on a hard and flat surface. The grade must be less than 2°.
- 3. Please push the drum when operating the drum caddy.

Operation

- 1. Remove the handle from the dolly.
- 2. Use the prongs on the handle to push the top of the drum forward, lifting the front of the drum.
- 3. Slide the dolly under the drum.
- 4. Once the drum rests fully on top of the dolly, attach the handle back to the dolly.
