The **Foundations® Wall Seat** is a child seat for use in commercial applications under the following conditions:

- · For use with children up to 50 lbs. (23 kg).
- The seat is properly mounted to a wall and properly maintained.

🛕 WARNING 🛕

- The Failure to follow these warnings and the installation instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- The enclosed hardware is only for through-wall mounting on a 1 in. (25 mm) thick partition.
- The Wall Seat is no stronger than the anchors or walls to which it is attached.
- · Contact an architect or building contractor for mounting on other wall construction.
 - Mount so bottom of Wall Seat is approximately 20-1/2 in. (520 mm) and top hole is 33 in. (840 mm) Above Finished Floor (AFF).
 - Each anchor must be capable of supporting a load of more than 75 lbs. (35 kg).
- All 4 screw locations MUST be used for safe installation.
- · Check mounting hardware at least once a month to ensure screws are tightly fastened.
- · DO NOT discard these instructions.

Message to Installer:

- · Adult installation required.
- Read all instructions before installing Wall Seat and placing into service.
- Unpack and identify all parts included before starting installation.
- Inspect Wall Seat for any freight damage after unpacking and before installation.
- Make sure there is adequate clearance in front of and to the side of the Wall Seat for safe operation and use.
- Never mount to a door.

PARTITION WALL INSTALLATION

- 1. Select the desired installation location.
- 2. Confirm partition wall is structurally sound and can support the wall seat with a child weighing 50 lb. (23 kg).
- 3. Measure 33 in. (840 mm) Above Finished Floor (AFF) and mark the partition for the top left attachment hole. (See *Fig.* 1)
- 4. Using a level and measuring tape, mark the partition wall for the remaining three (3) holes as seen in Fig. 1.
- 5. Align Top Left hole of Wall Seat with mark on Partition Wall and double check alignment of all marks.
- 6. After setting the Wall Seat down, use a power drill and 3/8 in. (9.5 mm) bit to drill 4 holes through partition at marked mounting points.
- 7. From opposite side of Partition Wall, insert the 4 T-Nuts into mounting holes and press until they are flush to the surface of the partition.




Fig. 2 (Seat belt hidden for clarity)

- 8. Align holes in Wall Seat with drilled holes and secure top left corner of wall seat to partition using a machine screw and flat washer into the T-nuts. (See Fig. 2) Do not tighten at this point.
- 9. Continue to secure the 3 remaining corners using the machine screws and flat washers into the T-nuts. (See Fig. 2)
- 10. After all screws are in place, tighten all screws.
- 11. Snap the 4 caps into the mounting holes the in Wall Seat. Check that all caps are fully seated into the Wall Seat.
- 12. Operate seat 3 or 4 times to ensure proper function and installation.
