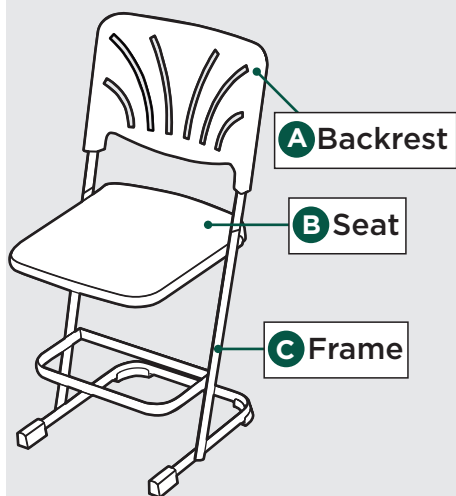


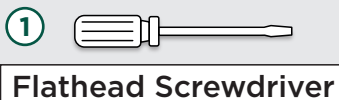
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

6600B SERIES | BACKREST FOR THE ELEPHANT Z-STOOL

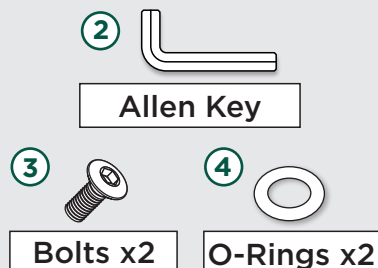
STOOL PARTS



TOOLS NEEDED

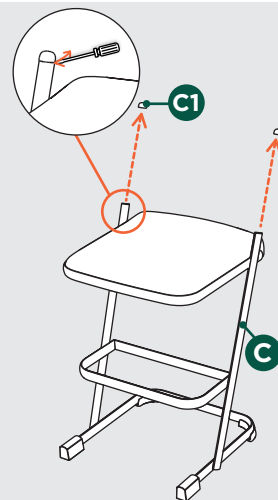


INCLUDED HARDWARE

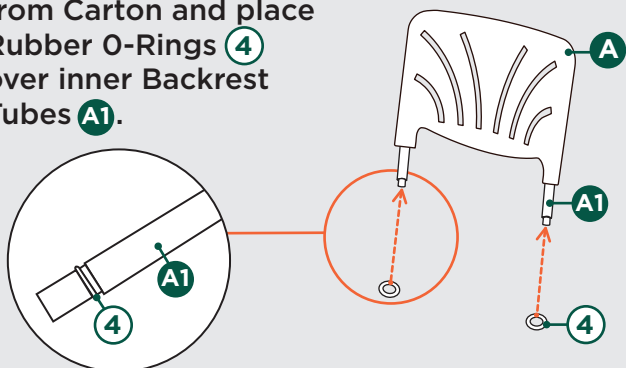


BACKREST INSTALLATION

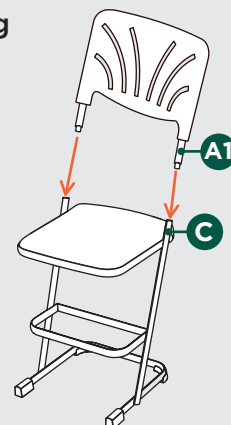
- Carefully remove Tube Closures **C1** that are located on top of each side Frame **C** of the Stool. This should be done by gently inserting a thin Screwdriver **1** underneath the Tube Closure and carefully prying upwards.



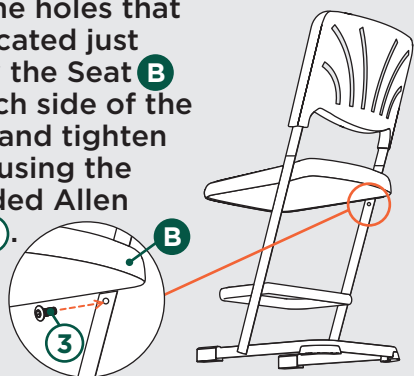
- Remove Backrest **A** from Carton and place Rubber O-Rings **4** over inner Backrest Tubes **A1**.



- Begin installation by aligning Metal Tubes that protrude from the Backrest **A1** with the opening of the Stool Frames **C**. Simultaneously insert both ends of the Backrest Tubes into the Stool opening. Gently push until Backrest Tubes are flush with Stool.

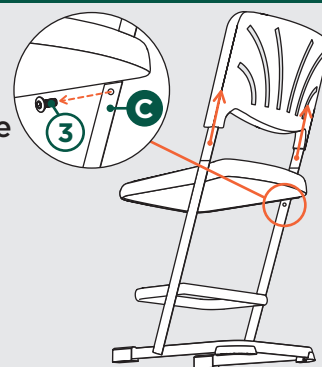


- Insert the Bolts **3** into the holes that are located just below the Seat **B** on each side of the Stool and tighten them using the provided Allen Key **2**.



BACKREST REMOVAL

Remove Bolts **3** from Frame **C** with provided Allen key **2**. The Backrests **A** are built to fit very tightly into the Stool Frame and some resistance may be encountered while attempting to remove. For easiest removal **do not pull** from plastic part of Backrest but rather place hands at the bottom of the Tubes **A1** on each side and pull while wiggling the Tubes upwards.



Double check all Bolts to be tightened securely before use. Check all Bolts periodically. Failure to completely tighten the Bolts may result in tipping and possible injury!
