

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS









STEP 1

Lay the seat base (B) on a flat, clean surface with the slats facing up. Attach rear seat slat (H) to the seat base (B) using 2 screws (AA).



STEP 2

Attach the front legs (F1, F2) onto the seat base (B) using 4 bolts with nuts (DD). Align with predrilled holes facing out. Ensure all bolts are in before fully tightening. Ensure all nuts are flush with the inside of the seat base (B) as shown.






STEP 3


Attach the vertical backrest supports (E) to the back of seat base (B). Back rest supports should be attached on the inside with 4 bolts and nuts (EE). Ensure all bolts are in before fully tightening. Ensure all nuts are flush with the inside of the vertical backrest supports (E) as shown.



STEP 4

Attach the armrests (C, D) to the front of the legs (F1, F2) using 2 bolts and nuts (DD). Armrests should be on the outside of the legs and vertical backrest supports. Bolts will be attached from the inside with the nut facing the outside as shown.

Attach the cross beam (G) to the front of the legs (F1, F2) using 4 screws (AA).
