




### SB 1383: Quick Overview

**Effective January 1, 2022:** regulations to meet statewide organics reduction and food recovery requirements take effect

**Effective January 1, 2024:** regulations may require local jurisdictions to impose penalties for noncompliance on regulated entities subject to authority

### **Objective**

Reduce organic waste disposal by 75% by 2025

Increase edible food recovery by 20% by 2025


#### **Implementation**






### Important Dates



2022: Provide organics collection service to residents and businesses. Establish edible recovery program. Conduct education and outreach. Procurement and capacity planning.



January 1, 2022: regulations for organics reduction and food recovery take effect.



January 1, 2024: impose penalties for noncompliance
