

Plastic Breath Guards Care and Use Instructions





How to Clean Plexiglas® and Acrylic:

- Always use a clean soft lint free cloth or micro fiber cloths along with a cleaning solution or products specifically made for cleaning Plexiglas® and acrylic plastic.
- Clean Plexiglas and acrylic with a neutral cleaner such as a solution of warm water and a small amount of dish detergent.
- Recommended cleaners for Plexiglas® and acrylic include: Novus® #1, Plexiclear, and Brillianize.

WHAT NOT TO DO:

- **Do not** use cleaners containing ammonia, alcohol, acetone or dry cleaning products. Cleaners with these chemicals will damage Plexiglas®, acrylic and other plastics.
- **Do not** use paper towels, abrasive materials, scratching cleansers, razor blades, brushes, steel wool or scouring pads, such as Scotch Brite® pads.
- **Do not** use WD-40[®] or petroleum, industrial or commercial cleaning products.

REMOVING MINOR SCRATCHES:

Fine scratches can be removed with a specialized mild abrasive polish such as Novus® #2, or Novus® #3. Heavier scratches, such that you can feel with your fingernail, will require some elbow effort to remove with a bit of sanding and buffing. A series of grits (250, 400, 600) followed by a buffing wheel and available buffing compound, will restore the luster of your Plexiglas® or acrylic.
