BACK

2. Use handrails, when provided, while ascending or descending.
3. **NEVER** climb or descend a ladder or WP from the side.
4. **DO NOT** over reach. If items **CAN NOT** be reached **SAFELY**, step down from the ladder or WP and reposition the ladder or WP.
5. **DO NOT** "walk", "jog" or "roll" the ladder or WP when standing on it.
6. **DO NOT** stand, climb, or sit on the railing, braces or base panel.
7. **DO NOT** overload, observe load rating label.
8. **ALWAYS** keep the ladder or WP close to work. Avoid pushing or pulling off to either side of the ladder or WP.

PROPER CARE AND STORAGE:

1. Replace all worn rubber feet, wheels and casters.
2. Store in a safe and dry place.
3. Properly secure while in transit.
4. **NEVER** store materials on the ladder or WP.
5. Keep clean, free from grease, oil and all slippery and foreign materials. Keep your shoes clean.
6. Destroy any ladders or WP's that are broken, worn or if exposed to fire or chemical corrosion.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR LADDERS & (WP) WORK PLATFORMS

PROPER LADDER SELECTION:

1. Select a ladder or WP of proper height to reach the work.

INSPECTION:

1. Inspect upon receipt and before each use. Never climb if damaged, bent or broken. All parts **MUST** be in good working order.
2. Make sure all nuts and bolts are tightly fastened. Also, all steps and wheels **MUST** be secure.
3. **NEVER** make temporary repairs for a damaged or missing part.
4. Check operation of brake mechanism, when present. Legs **MUST** set firmly on floor when ladder or WP is occupied.

PROPER SET-UP:

1. Place on firm level surface with a secure footing.
2. **DO NOT** use on slippery surfaces.
3. **DO NOT** place on boxes, unstable bases or on scaffolds to gain additional height.
4. **DO NOT** place in front of a door that opens toward the ladder or WP.

PROPER CLIMBING AND USE:

1. **DO NOT** use if you tire easily, are subject to fainting spells, are using medication or alcohol, or are physically handicapped.
