ASSEMBLY/ARRIVAL

1. It is the responsibility of the recipient to inspect the shipment for damage prior to signing the bill of lading. Damages must be reported to your authorized retailer within 5 days of receipt.
2. Inspect all welds and fasteners on table & base for damage before use. Ensure all legs are straight and touching the floor.
3. Assembly, if applicable, should be conducted by a qualified adult using the applicable instructions.



STORAGE

1. After assembly, do not store upside down.
2. Extreme temperatures should be avoided. For long-term storage, move to a covered area.



ONGOING MAINTENANCE

1. It is recommended to use placemats and coasters to prevent scratches, scrapes, and warping. If damage is caused by misuse, it may not be covered by the warranty.
2. Avoid excess moisture on table tops. Wipe off tables after inclement weather and spills.

MONTHLY

1. Ensure the structure is sound and there are no cracks or breaks in the material. Tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten since this may damage the material.



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

METAL

1. Clean using a solution of mild soap or detergent with warm water. Recommended: Noble Lemon Lance (147LMNLANRQT).
2. For dried-on dirt, clean with a soft brush and a mild cleaner. Recommended: Noble Spiffy Shine (999SPIFSHINE).
3. Make sure metal is fully dry after cleaning and before use to prevent rusting and other discoloration. Use a clean, dry cloth or a soft duster to dust weekly.

LAMINATE

1. Clean using a mild soap with warm water and a clean cloth, or use a mild cleaner with a clean cloth. For harder stains, use a soft bristled brush along with a mild cleaner. Recommended Cleaners: Noble AllSurf (999ALLSURF), Noble Strike (147STRIQEQT), and Noble Reflect (147REFLECTQT).
2. Do not use abrasive cleaners or products. Use a clean, dry cloth to dry and make sure material is fully dry before use to prevent warping or damage to the finish. As these are the result of misuse, they may not be covered under warranty.



CAUTION

1. Do not use a table if any parts are broken or missing. This includes screws, fasteners, and feet/glides.
2. Do not remove any safety labels.
3. Always follow cleaning and maintenance instructions.
4. Do not let anyone sit, stand, shake, lean, jump, or climb on table. Do not use this product as a support when leaning and/or standing.
5. To avoid warping or discoloration, rain should not be left sitting on the table top for long periods of time. Extreme temperatures or temperature changes should also be avoided.
