# Product Use and Care Instructions



FMP Item Nos. 133-1002, 133-1003, 133-1008, 133-1009, 133-1207, 133-1208

### Wash First Before Use

- Thoroughly wash with dish detergent and hot water before first use.
- Your portable griddle/broiler has been coated with a protective food grade preservative which may collect dust and debris. An initial washing with standard dish detergent will remove the coating and debris.

#### **Use and Care Recommendations**

"Curing"

- Before cooking for the fist time, after the initial cleaning, lightly coat the cooking surface with cooking oil and heat the griddle/broiler until the oil smokes.
- Shut off burners.
- Allow the griddle/broiler to cool, then wipe off cooking surface. It is now "cured" and conditioned for use.

## **Heating Instructions**

- The griddle/broiler must be placed evenly over the required number of burners:
  - Two burners required for FMP numbers 133-1008, 133-1002, and 133-1207
  - Four burners required for FMP numbers 133-1009, 133-1003, and 133-1208
- The flame on each burner must be adjusted and maintained equally for all burners.
- The required number of burners must be used at all times to maintain even heating.
- For best results, the griddle/broiler should be preheated slowly and evenly.

## **Cleaning and Storing**

- Allow the griddle/broiler to cool before immersing in water. Immersing a very hot griddle/broiler in water may cause the surface to warp
- The griddle/broiler can be cleaned using: dish detergent, scouring pad, scraper, stiff brush, or by putting through the dishwasher. AVOID USING ABRASIVE CLEANERS.
- Towel dry immediately after rinsing and apply a light coat of cooking oil before storing to protect finish.
