


AA	4*35 Screw	8PCS	DD	M8*80 Bolt	2PCS

Attach the rear seat slat (Part H) to the seat (Part B) with 4*35 screws (Part AA)




STEP 2

Attach the legs (Part F) to the seat (Part B) with M8*50 bolts (Part BB)




**Pre-drilled hole on front leg facing front.

Attach the crossbeam (Part G) to the legs (Part F) with 4*35 screws (Part AA)




STEP 4

Attach the hinge (Part E) to the seat (Part B) with M8*50 bolts (Part BB)




Attach the right armrest (Part C) and left armrest (Part D) to the legs (Part F) with M8*50 bolts bolts (Part BB)




STEP 6

Attach the right armrest (Part C) and left armrest (Part D) to the backrest (Part A) with M8*80 bolts (Part DD)

Attach the hinges (Part E) to the backrest (Part A) with M8*50 bolts (Part CC)




