USE DIRECTIONS



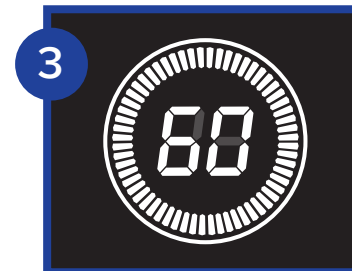
VISIBLE SOILS:

- Remove any particles or soils from the surface
If bodily fluid spill, follow internal bodily fluid procedures



SANITIZE:

- Wipe surface until completely wet
- Make sure the entire surface has come in contact with the wipe



AIR DRY:

- For food-contact surface sanitization, surface is to remain wet for 60 seconds.
- No rinse required
For non-food contact surface sanitization, refer to product label for appropriate contact time.
