Assembly Instructions

Critical Information

General Assembly: When pressing components into place, be careful not to pinch yourself.

Weight Capacity: The total weight capacity of the unit is 175 lb.

Do Not Overload: Do not exceed the listed weight capacity.

Tools: If using a rubber mallet to secure parts, do not hammer them into place. Gently tap until the part is seated.

Installation Requirements

WARNING - Installation Location

- Incorrect placement can violate codes, create access issues, or compromise evacuation routes.
- The unit shall not be installed in public corridors or lobbies.
- Do not install the unit in areas that may block emergency exits or public pathways.

Initial Setup

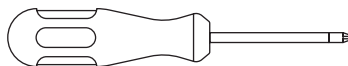
Initial Use: This cart is intended for commercial cleaning and maintenance use. When not in use, store indoors.

Inspect the Packaging: Examine the unit's packaging for any signs of damage that may have occurred during shipping.

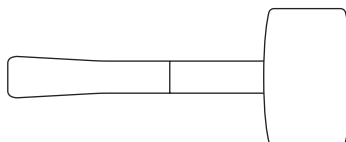
Unboxing:

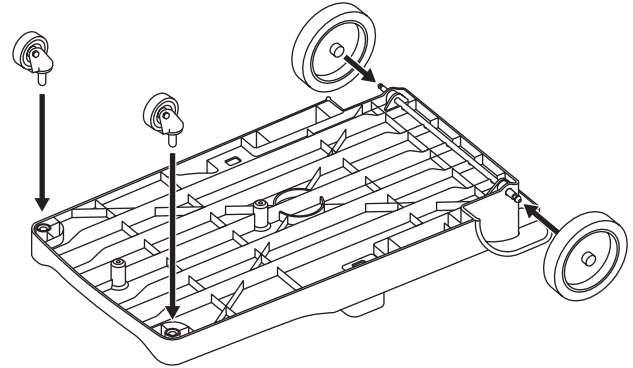
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Assembly

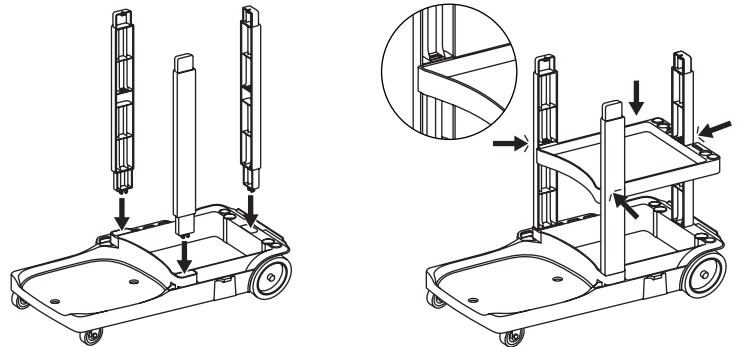
Step 1 - Wheel Installation

- Turn over the base plate.
- Press the rear wheels onto the axle until they snap in place.
- Install front wheels into the designated holes and secure them by pressing or tapping into place with a rubber mallet.



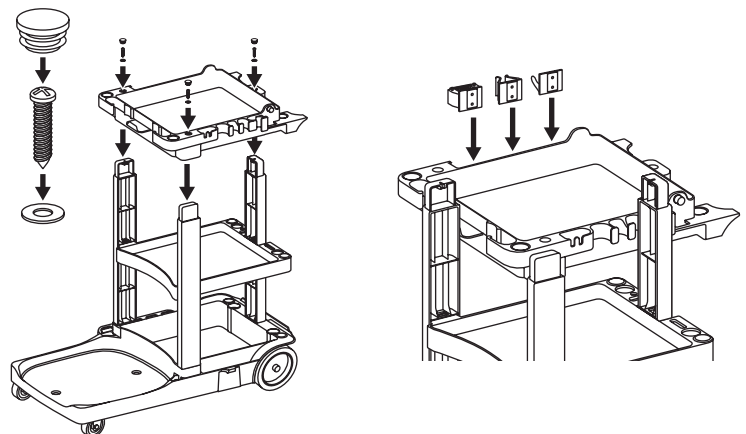
Step 2 - Middle Tray and Pillar Assembly

- Install pillars into the base plate mounting locations.
- Mount the middle tray onto the pillars at the designated middle position until it snaps into place.



Step 3 - Top Tray Assembly

- Position the top tray on the pillars.
- Secure using tapping screws and washers. Use small insert plugs to cover screws.
- Install the hook, clip, and mop hanger onto the right side of the top tray.

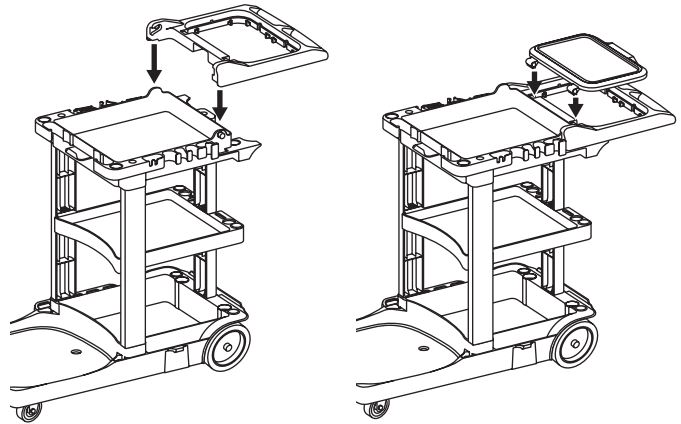


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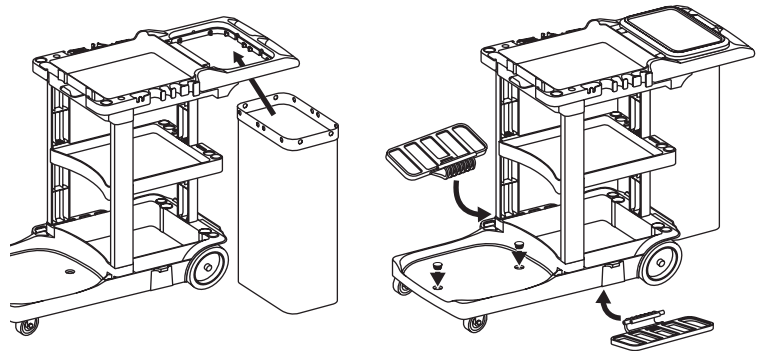
Step 4 - Handle and Lid

- Install the handrail into the top tray mounts.
- Press the lid into the mounts located in the handle.
- Verify the lid opens and closes smoothly after installation.



Step 5 - Accessories and Mop Rack Installation

- The mop racks will mount under the base plate.
NOTE: You may flip the cart upside down to access the mop rack mounting location.
- Hang the bag on the installed hooks.
- Insert the large plugs into the base tray holes.



Step 6 - Completion

- Confirm all components are installed.
- Assembly is complete, and the cart is ready for use.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Daily Cleaning: Remove loose debris and wipe down with a damp cloth or mild soap solution to prevent buildup.

Deep Cleaning: Use a degreaser safe for plastic to remove dirt.

Assembling Inspection: Regularly inspect parts and ensure structural integrity.

Wheels: Check for worn-out wheels, flat spots, or uneven damage. Replace wheels that make the cart difficult to maneuver.
