Use & Care Guide

BISTRO SERIES CHAIRS & BARSTOOLS





ARRIVAL

- It is the responsibility of the recipient to inspect the shipment for damage prior to signing the bill of lading. Damages must be reported to your authorized retailer within 5 days of receipt.
- Inspect all welds and fasteners on chairs/barstools for damage before use. Ensure all legs are straight and touching the floor.



STORAGE

- 1. After assembly, do not store upside down.
- 2. Do not stack higher than 4 chairs or barstools together. Use caution when stacking and unstacking.
- When storing outdoor furniture long term, cover or move to an enclosed / covered area.



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

TESLIN / RATTAN MATERIAL:

- Use a clean, dry cloth to brush off any dirt or debris. Spray with a hose or rinse with water if necessary.
- Dry material with a clean, dry cloth when wet.
 Make sure material is fully dry after cleaning and before use to prevent discoloration.
- 3. Do not use abrasive cleaners or products.

ALUMINUM FRAME:

- Use a clean cloth with mild soap and warm water to clean the aluminum frame. Rinse the frame with clean water to rinse off the soap.
- 2. Completely dry the frame with a clean, dry cloth. Ensure there is no accumulation of water inside the frame.





CAUTION

- 1. 1. Do not exceed weight capacity limit of 330 lb.
- Do not stand on chairs/barstools. Do not shake or sway while in use. Keep all four legs on the ground when in use.
- To prevent water spots, do not allow water to pool / stand on the surface of the seat or back.
- 4. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on the teslin or rattan materials, as this can damage the material and affect its appearance.
- 5. Avoid dragging the furniture on the ground, as scratches that chip the frame finish can cause oxidation.
