COMPONENTS

- VINYL SEATS & BACKS
- WOOD SEATS AND BACKS

ASSEMBLY/ARRIVAL

- Inspect furniture and do not use if any parts are damaged or missing.
- It is the responsibility of the recipient to inspect the shipment for damage prior to signing the bill of lading. Damages must be reported to your authorized retailer within 5 days of receipt.



ONGOING MAINTENANCE

- Tighten all bolts and screws monthly to ensure structure is sound.
- Use a clean, dry cloth or a soft duster to dust weekly.
- It is recommended to use placemats and coasters on tables to prevent scratches, scrapes, and warping.
- Check for rips, stains, marks, loose seams, and other damage before use.



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

METAL PARTS

- Clean using a solution of mild soap or detergent with warm water. Recommended: Noble Lemon Lance (147LMNLANRQT).
- For dried-on dirt, clean with a soft brush and a mild cleaner.
- Make sure metal is fully dry and clean before use to prevent rusting and other discoloration. If issues arise due to misuse, they may not be covered by the warranty.

WOOD PARTS

- Do not use abrasive cleaners or products.
- Use a clean, soft cloth to dust furniture weekly. Dust in the direction of grain to prevent visible scratching.
- Clean with a mild soap and damp cloth and dry with a dry cloth.
- If you are using a new soap or cleaner, test first on an area that may not be shown.
- Make sure wood is fully dry after cleaning and before use to prevent warping or damage to the finish. If issues arise due to misuse, they may not be covered by the warranty.

VINYL

Clean with a mild soap. Recommended: Noble All Surf (47ALLSRF2HG).



CAUTION

- Chairs and barstools are intended to be used indoors on a stable and level surface. Do not use if the chair or barstool is not level.
- Do not use furniture if any parts are broken, damaged, or missing. This includes screws, fasteners, and feet/ glides.
- Do not remove any safety labels.
- Always follow cleaning and maintenance instructions.
- Do not shake or sway while in use. Do not stand on chairs, barstools, or tables. Keep all four legs of chairs/barstools on the ground.
- Make sure table and table top are both balanced, stable, and secure. Do not use if table base is not level.
- Adult supervision is necessary if being used by children.
