

# **Floor Mounted Mop Sink**

**Assembly Instructions** 

### TOOLS REQUIRED

Drain Key (included) Large Flat Screw Driver

## **s:** (1) Sink

- (B) (1) "Z" Mounting Bracket
- C (1) Drain


## Detailed View of Drain Assembly

### Assembly Instructions

1. Install "Z" mounting bracket 2 1/4" above floor.

Distance from wall to center of stub pipe: 16" x 20" Sink: 10 1/2" 20" x 28" Sink: 12 1/2" 24" x 24" Sink: 14 1/2" **NOTE:** Hardware not included. These measurements do not apply to corner sink models

- 2. Assemble mop sink drain to mop sink. **NOTE:** Do not install top strainer plate, rubber gland, or brass compression nut at this time.
- 3. Position mop sink over 2" I.P.S. stub pipe while securing rear strap onto "Z" mounting bracket. **NOTE:** 2" pipe stub must protrude 3" above finished floor for proper installation. Recommend using silicone sealant between bottom of mop sink apron and floor.
- 4. Insert rubber gland over 2" I.P.S. stub pipe (use liquid soap on gland for easy installation). Thread brass compression nut over rubber gland.
- 5. Insert drain key into brass compression nut (**FIGURE 1**). Using flat blade screw driver, tighten compression nut to ensure tight seal between rubber gland and 2" pipe stub. Remove drain key and secure strainer plate to top of drain.

**WARNING!** Risk of personal injury. Stainless steel edges are sharp and can cause cuts. Wear gloves during installation and handle with care.
