
Smokers' Outpost

PARTS LIST

- (1) Smokers' Outpost model with warning sticker on base
- (1) Galvanized collection pail

Assembly Instructions:

- Verify that the galvanized collection pail is in base of unit by unscrewing the top from the base. Never use the Smoker's Outpost without the galvanized collection pail in place.
- 2. Tightly secure the top back onto the base using the fastening knob.
- Failure to follow each of these instructions may increase risk of fire.
 NOTE: The receptacle is an oxygen-restricting cigarette container.
 Do not add sand or water to the Smoker's Outpost galvanized collection pail.



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

Check and empty the Smokers' Outpost frequently and based on actual usage. It is recommended that the Smokers' Outpost be checked at least once a day. Units in high-traffic areas must be checked and cleaned more frequently. Empty before cigarette butts fill three quarters of the collection pail. Following inspections and cleanings, be sure to reinstall the galvanized collection pail check that the unit closes and seals airtight, and check that the fastening knob is tightly secured before placing the unit back in use. Failure to follow these instructions may increase the risk of fire.

Cleaning and Maintenance:

- 1. Release top from base. Top has a snap-lock fit. Hold base with feet and pull off the top (see Fig. a).
- 2. Empty collection pail (see Fig. b).
- 3. To minimize tar buildup and odors, periodically clean the unit with a household degreaser or cleaner. Make sure to allow cleaner time to evaporate before reassembling.
- 4. Remove any materials, such as cigarette butts, which may be blocking the smokestack.
- 5. Replace collection pail and tightly secure the top to the base using the snap-lock fit. Be sure the unit is closed and sealed airtight after each cleaning.
