



# Stock Pot Dolly

## CARE AND USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

### DO:

- Ensure careful placement of stock pot in an upright position to prevent damage when maneuvering it in and out of the dolly.
- Pair with cover and roll on a flat surface to ensure contents do not spill.
- Avoid abrupt movements to prevent contents from splashing.
- Utilize coworkers to lift objects that are too heavy for an individual.
- Ensure adherence to authoritative lifting guidelines.
- Lift with proper posture and avoid carrying loads that block your view.
- Use the proper gear when dealing with heavy, hot, or cumbersome objects.
- Keep a fire extinguisher, first aid kit, wet floor signs, and other safety gear in the kitchen.

### DO NOT:

- Roll over obstructions, preventing spillage and equipment damage.
- Overfill pots, preventing contents from spilling or boiling over.
- Lift bulky or heavy items by yourself, preventing injury.
- Dismiss or ignore authoritative lifting guidelines, preventing injury.
- Touch hot metal, exercising caution when dealing with hot objects.
- Neglect maintenance, making sure to regularly service and maintain all safety and kitchen equipment.

### Use and Care Statement:

Use nonabrasive tools when cleaning the dolly (soft cloths, pads, or bristle brushes) in combination with a cleaning spray specifically formulated for stainless steel. Do not expose the dolly to chlorides or chlorinated cleaner. Over time, they can result in stainless steel becoming pitted, which makes the surface susceptible to rust and corrosion. Wipe in the same direction of existing polishing marks to preserve the product's shine. Ensure the dolly is thoroughly dry after cleaning.
