The mount boasts four suction cup feet, keeping the cutter securely in place while cutting.

Thanks to the razor-sharp stainless steel blade assembly, this powerhouse machine consistently creates 1/2" fries out of a potato up to 6" long in a fraction of the time that wedging or slicing by hand requires. You can even use this cutter to prep onions, peppers, celery, and other vegetables! To provide you with years of trouble-free operation, this unit's durable cast aluminum construction resists misalignment problems, which can cause nicks, scuffs, and broken blades. Sharp stainless steel blades ensure precise, consistent cuts and will resist corrosion due to the acidic juices of tomatoes and other foods, while a short throw handle with superior engineering enhances leverage for smooth, easy cutting in just one stroke.
