

This umbrella base is constructed of durable concrete that ensures your umbrella won't blow away or tip over when it's windy outside. It's suitable for holding umbrellas with poles 1 1/2" in diameter. Plus, its 28 lb. weight allows it to be sturdy yet lightweight enough to relocate if you need to use it elsewhere. Because of its weight, this umbrella base needs to be lifted with caution and preferably with the help of a second person to ensure employee safety.

This umbrella base's black color and round shape are sure to add an upscale touch to your outdoor seating. The round design is free of sharp edges so guests don't hurt their feet. Its concrete construction is not easily breakable, so you can use it with confidence in a commercial setting. Plus, its compact design maximizes leg and foot space!
