INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

First, scrape and remove as much solid food and waste as possible. Wash dishes and pans in recommended dilution of PAN PRO I thoroughly in clear, hot water.

Dishes: Use 1 oz. to 3 gallons water.

Pots & Pans: Dilute 1 oz. to 2 gallons water.

Heavy-Duty Cleaning: Use 1 oz. to 1 gallons water.
