Thanks to a 8 1/2" long gooseneck spout, this faucet delivers water exactly where you need it, and the moveable swivel, high-clearance gooseneck design lets you move it to fill multi-compartment sinks or maneuver around larger cooking vessels. It's also a great option for hand-washing, too! Water exits the faucet through a 2 GPM aerator, which creates a soft flow pattern with minimal splashing. This faucet is designed for use in janitorial and dishwashing applications only, and is not intended for applications where the fixture will be used to supply drinking water, or water for cooking.

The faucet installs on your sink deck or countertop on a pair of 8" centers and connects to the facility water lines with a set of 1/2" NPS inlets. The faucet body is made from chrome-plated brass that complements nearly any design aesthetic, and the water flow is controlled by a pair of simple lever handles.
