

This versatile Regency three compartment stainless steel commercial sink offers you the divided bowls that you need to efficiently clean your dishes at an affordable price! Constructed with 16-gauge type 304 stainless steel, this sink's three compartments allow you to conveniently complete the entire dishwashing process--washing, rinsing, and sanitizing--within the same compact unit.

This three compartment commercial sink rests atop four galvanized tubular legs with galvanized sockets and adjustable plastic feet. It features a 10 3/4" backsplash with two holes punched on 8" centers to accommodate a wall-mounted faucet (sold separately). The front and sides have a 2 1/2" rolled edge to help contain splashes and overflow.

Each compartment is 12" deep with a 3 1/2" basket strainer. For easy cleaning, each compartment has rounded corners.
